The course is taught via online lectures, practical sessions and tutorials from the USW teaching staff. This is then supported by the MFC Foundation staff throughout the programme. The programme will predominantly be based at the Herlingshaw Centre in Eston, with some time also spent at the Riverside Stadium and Rockliffe.

Students will also complete work - based learning hours on MFC Foundation programmes. At MFC Foundation our goal is to inspire confidence and hope in the people in our community. We pride ourselves on great teamwork and coming together when it really matters the most.

Course Fees

£8,000 per year (£9,000 for the Top-Up year)

RESIDENTIAL VISITS

The University blends online and traditional teaching methods to create an active, social community of learning in sport.
